ML204 God's Chain of Command

Camuel rebuked Saul for disobeying the LORD's direct needs. Only those who submit to His chain of command Command: "... Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams" [1Sa 15:22].

The LORD is the Commander and Chief of the entire universe. This covers all things - visible and invisible. Yet we need to know His instructions to the authorities under Him.

Paul says this in 1Cor 11:3: "But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God." Four levels: God, Christ, Man, Woman. This is plain enough; the woman should obey the man, the man should obey Christ, and Christ did obey God.

God gave each entity a will to do as it pleases, i.e., the option to follow the leader or follow the world. Because we have this option, we can choose God's chain of command, create a chain of our own, or follow our own carnal ways.


If you choose the wrong option, understand that God is not obligated to answer your prayers and supply your
