

ML306 Singing your own Song

Babes in Christ are eager to sing their songs to family, friends, and even to strangers. We older folks should share their zeal, but past tradition had us handing out tracks instead of singing our songs. Had we known better, we would have shared like these did:

Ac 2:46: And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart."

These words are not symbols. The disciples went from house to house sharing their personal testimonies. The next verse confirms this: *"Praising God, and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved"* [Acts 2:47].

They understood what Paul wrote in Ro 2:4: *"... not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance."* A Track is a poor substitute for a personal testimony. Without human witnesses, the Word is difficult

for some unbelievers to hear. Your testimony is not only easy to hear, it's also easy to believe.

Jos 2:10-11: For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you,.... And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

Read the story of Rahab in Jos 2:3-9 and then read the words of her song:

God equips all babes in Christ to win souls for the Lord. They need not memorize certain scriptures. They don't need any special instructions; there's nothing for them to learn — they already know what to say, what song to sing. Each babe in Christ knows how Jesus saved him or her from sin — these are the lyrics of their songs. They only need to sing what they already know.
